

ReMap strikes back

AN INTERNATIONAL contemporary art platform held every two years in the area of Kerameikos and Metaxourgeio in Athens in tandem with the Athens Biennial, this year's ReMap 3 will be serving as a meeting place for over 250 artists, art historians and curators from around the world. The 50 plus exhibitions and projects hosted by ReMap3 will be presenting visitors an alternative route in Kerameikos and Metaxourgeio, an area that is developing into a contemporary cultural hub in the centre of Athens and is home to the new Athens Municipal Art Gallery, the Athens Film Archive, the Kunsthalle Athena, The Breder and Rebecca Camhi galleries, the ATOPOS Contemporary Visual Culture and a host of theatres including

the new Synergy-o experimental stage and the internationally renowned Attis Theatre.

Over the six weeks of the ReMap3 programme, all these institutions will coexist with ReMap3 exhibitions and projects, which are to be temporarily housed in unused spaces throughout the area which are far from typical classic exhibition venues such as museums, art fairs and galleries. *From September 12 to October 30 at various venues around Kerameikos and Metaxourgeio. ReMap3's info point will be based in the courtyard of an old house in the central Avdi square.*
